As far as possible all parents will be made aware of whom their child will be travelling with before the trip.

All children must have a booster seat if they require one. If they do not I am afraid we will **not** be able to transport them and they will remain in school with a member of staff.

'Every child under the age of 12 who measures less than 135cm (4ft 5in) is required to use a booster seat or cushion. However, the Department for Transport recommends that children should continue using booster cushions or booster seats until they are 150cm (4ft 11in) tall.' (taken from Booster Seat Laws, Regulations and Requirements)

Following the above guide lines all children under 135cm must be provided with a seat if parents wish them to travel.
