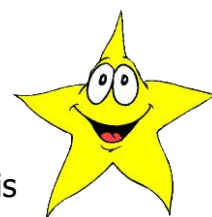
What's on this week:

Fruit juice



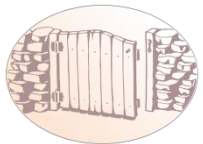
If you could consider this list when packing your harvest gifts, that would be very helpful. Thankyou.
