For the first two weeks of this term, we have been finishing off our dinosaur topic, making fossils and volcanos. The boys are very excited that we are going to make them 'erupt' next week! Watch out for it on the website.

We were planning 'Minibeasts 'as our next topic, but the boys have asked if they can do 'Superheroes' next so that's what it is! We will launch our topic Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May with a superhero day, where the boys can come dressed in any superhero costume or borrow one from school (we have plenty). We envisage that it will be a very physical topic that will involve lots of den/cave building and making traps to catch' baddies; (the boys words), so, weather permitting we will be outside and at forest school. Some of you have already kindly volunteered your time, but if anyone does have any free time Monday -Thursday, to come to Forest school, it would be greatly appreciated. As a school we have bought two subscriptions to the online programs Reading eggs and Mathletics, passwords have been stuck in the front of your child's home/school diary for you to use these games at home as well. Please ask if you have any gueries.

Our Literacy work this half-term will link with our topic work. We will be looking at recounts, comic strips and traditional tales ( some of which have superheroes in), for the children to write their own stories. I think that we will get some amazing stories with this topic!



In our Maths lessons we will be looking at estimating, using the language 'more' and 'fewer' to compare two sets of objects, weight and capacity and securing knowledge on previous topics.





This term we will be consolidating the children's knowledge by reading/spelling two syllable words, reading captions, reading/spelling tricky words and words

with adjacent consonants. Please come and watch our phonics lessons again, I think that you will be amazed by how much the children know!



All the children will be reading in guided reading group, as well as reading individually. Please remember to change your child's home reading book regularly so that you can support your child's reading at home.
