### **Meet the Teacher**

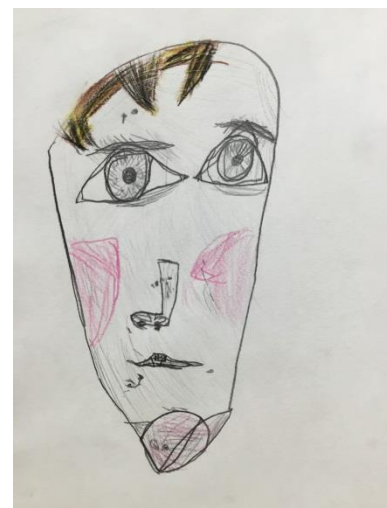
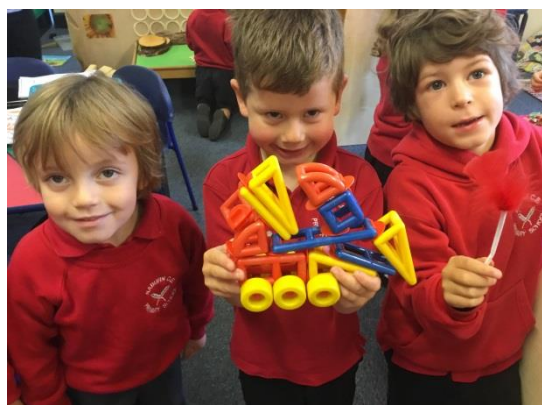
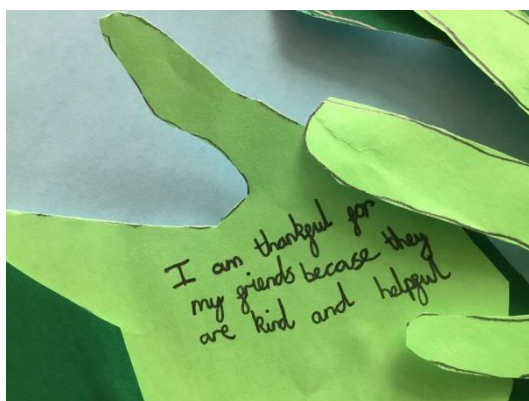
