

Oak Class Important Information



PE Kits

Children do PE on a **Monday** and a **Friday** so should ensure they have their kit in school on these days.

PE kit should include:

White T-shirt (with or without school logo)

Black shorts/black tracksuit bottoms

A pair of plimsolls and a pair of trainers for outdoor PE.

Homework

Children have been given tasks to complete over the term, please see the separate homework sheet for more information about how this is to be completed.

Spelling: Children should practise their spellings every week in preparation for our spelling test.

Times tables: children should continue to practise their times tables every week in preparation for our tables test.

Reading Diaries

Once a week, children are encouraged to create a verbal See-Saw post about the book they are reading – giving a brief description about what they have read that week, and how they are feeling about the book they have chosen.

The teacher will watch these once a week.

The children are also encouraged to create See-Saw posts with books they recommend – giving a brief description of the plot (no spoilers!) and why they would recommend it.

Bringing belongings in

Oak class have been provided with a learning pack, containing all the stationery they will need in class. Please refrain from bringing pencil cases into school, as they will not fit in their trays.

Children are allowed a small pencil case of colouring pencils, however these are to be kept in their bags during the day until needed.

Cloakroom

As we only have a small cloakroom – I ask that children only bring in essentials to school, such as their coat, PE bag and a small school bag.

We have had many incidents and issues with damaged and lost possessions as a result of an overcrowded cloakroom!
