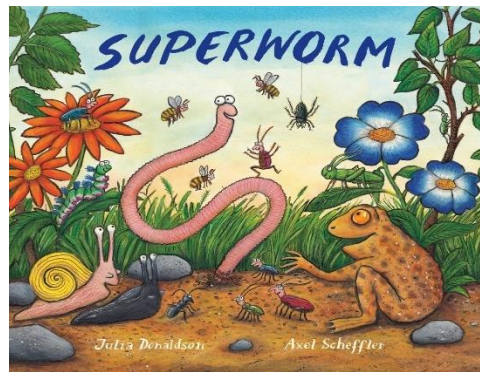
Kit List
