Half Term 1

Maths

This half term we will be focusing on Number and Place Value. We will look at the value of each digit in a number, recognise and represent numbers in different ways as well as order and compare increasingly larger numbers.



English

As part of our Treasure topic, we will be looking at the book *The Matchbox Diary* to create diary recounts inspired by treasured memories kept in matchboxes.

Following this, we will write our own newspaper recounts and will focus on editing and evaluating our own and other's writing.

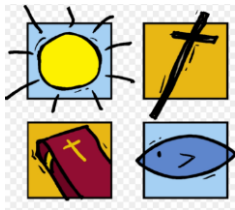
Topic

This term we will be learning about Hinduism. We will be considering what it means to be a Hindu living in Britain today.



Science

During this half term, we will focus on electricity. We will be constructing our own electrical circuits and identifying everyday electrical appliances. We will test whether a bulb will light in a circuit and introduce switches.
