DONATIONS TO SCHOOL

As well as being able to assist School with more significant purchess like the IT equipment and funding to renovate the infant / reception outside area we are also able to support School by providing funds to cover (amongst other things!) the end of year whole School trip, transport to Y5/6 residential, classroom funding support for books and resources as well as School Christmas parties & productions. As school budgets shrink, we help School buy necessities as well as the nice to haves and none of these would be possible without all of your hard work & efforts!

For those who are new to School, each year FONP have been lucky to secure the use of the St Crux Parish Hall at Pavement, York. This is one of our best fundraising activities of the year. Once again we have requested the use of the Hall and are waiting to hear when our booking will be. We usually run a cafe using donations from parents / carers, selling tea, coffee, soft drinks, cakes, sandwiches etc as well as having a general bric-a-brac sale outside. This is a great opportunity to get rid of all those old toys and books and all of the profits directly benefit the children at Naburn. Last year we were also able to support a local charity by donating all of our unsold items.

We usually raise in excess of £1000 which is a great achievement. As soon as we know when our booking is we will let you know but in the meantime if you are having a clear out please keep hold of anything which you would be happy to donate to us to sell on the day!
