Our topic this half term is 'Sand, Sea and Sunshine'. We will be learning about what there is to do at the seaside, and the things we might expect to see there. In **History** we will be learning about what seaside holidays in the past were like, discussing things such as how people travelled, where they went to, and the activities they did there. In Geography we will be finding out about different human and physical features of seas and coasts, as well as jobs and resources linked to the sea.

As we are sadly unable to go on school trips during the current pandemic situation, we will not be able to visit the seaside as we had planned to. Instead we have decided we are going to bring the seaside to Naburn! Our 'Seaside day' will take place on Tuesday 6th July. More information to follow.

We will be learning how to write poetry using our senses, and writing stories, letters and postcards linked to our topic.
