Naburn Primary School PTA are running a village-wide 100 CLUB and we are hoping everyone will join! For just £12 a year you have the chance to win up to £50 every month whilst raising much needed funds for your local school.

HOW WILL IT WORK?

Every month there will be a draw and 1 member of the club will win up to **£50** (or more if we get more members!).

Joining Fee: £12 one off annual fee covering your membership for 12 months & gives you 1 number in the draw.

The first draw will take place on 1st August 2021 and then on the first day of every month thereafter.

THE IMPORTANT BIT...

HOW DO I JOIN?

Complete & sign the attached membership form & payment £12 either by cash or cheque to the school office.

This buys 1 membership number (that we will allocate), which enters you into the monthly draw. All participants must be over 16 years of age (that's the law!).

The draw takes place on the first day of each month. If you win (hurrah!) a cheque will be posted to your home address & the name of the winner will be published on the school newsletter, website & social media.

We are hoping to attract 100 members (hence the name 100 club!) and the prize money will be 50% of the membership fee taken that month. The remaining 50% goes to the school to help fund equipment, resources & opportunities for pupils. If we get 100 members this means a monthly prize of £50!

The club is being run by Naburn School PTA, also known as Friends of Naburn Primary School, a group of parents, teachers and people in the village who support the school - all profits are used to help run the school. As with all schools, Naburn has faced significant budget cuts in recent years. However, these cuts have affected our school more than most; the amount of funding a school receives is directly related to pupil numbers and as the smallest school in York this has a direct impact on our bottom line. It means fundraising events are essential to enable us to purchase all the equipment we need to ensure our children receive the varied and thorough learning experience they deserve. This year, the usual events have not been possible so we really hope you can help support us with the 100 club.

THE RULES

THE PURPOSE... of the 100 club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the PTA bank account & used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

1. For a cost of £12 per year you will be allocated one number between one and 100 and entered in to a monthly draw (equating to £1 per draw).
2. A draw will be made every month with one prize.
3. The prizes will total 50% of the annual income.
4. The 100 club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Naburn School. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
5. Numbers are limited to five per household.
6. Payments must be made by cash or annual cheque. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
7. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
8. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
9. The draw shall be made by the headteacher, or nominated other on the first working day of each calendar month.
10. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and on the school website.
12. The 100 club will be run by the PTA. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.
13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTA funds after six months.
