Let's Get Cooking Club (Mrs Mann)

We have had another brilliant 'Let's Get Cooking' club this week with the last group of children to take part this year. We always start our first session learning about the rules we need to remember when cooking such as tying long hair back, wearing aprons, the importance of keeping everything hygienically clean (including our hands) and lots more. This week we made scones! The children learned how to measure out ingredients, how to rub flour and butter together using their hands and how use other equipment to mix and divide their dough equally. 


Story: Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy is being called a hero by many as he is remains in his
