Sycamore Class Spring Newsletter – January 2023



Welcome to 2023 in Sycamore Class! We hope you all had a fabulous Christmas break and are enjoying January so far ... despite the rain! Please find below a flavour of what KS2 are up to this term.

English Year 3/4's first novel is **'The Secret Garden'** by Frances Hodgson Burnett and **Year 5/6**'s is **'Room 13'** by Robert Swindells – a children's classic and an adventure/thriller, respectively, which we will use to inspire our writing of persuasion, explanation, character and setting descriptions and suspense narratives.

Maths Y34 are concentrating on multiplication, division, measure, area, perimeter and fractions this term, whilst Y56 are focusing upon decimals, percentages, measure, area, perimeter, data handling and ratio. As always, times **table fluency** is the bedrock of most areas of maths so please do encourage your child(ren) to use TT Rockstars regularly at home.

Topic We are learning all about **farming.** We will be studying the features and characteristics of land use in agricultural regions across the world, including a detailed exploration of significant environmental areas.

Science is **Living Things** and **animal/human lifecycles**. In Y34 we will focus upon Animal Nutrition and the Skeletal System whilst in Y56 we will be looking at Life Cycles and Human Life.

RE Y34 will study the theme of **Journeys**, with the key question 'why do some people think that life is a journey?' whilst Y56 will be considering, **'What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?**

Other areas: PSHCE is based upon 'Dreams and goals' (eg: how to overcome challenges in our lives; how to empathise with others who face challenges). PE will be dance (Tuesdays) and health related exercise (Fridays), taught by Total Sports. Please ensure that your child(ren) wear PE kit (*white top/red hoody/black or grey shorts/leggings and trainers*) on both of those days and have long hair tied back. Spanish We are learning about the calendar and celebrations this term. Computing We will be using 'Scratch' to design, write and debug programs.
